



Choice Based Lettings - The New Way to Find a Home

A1 Housing on behalf of Bassetlaw District Council will operate the Homefinder Scheme.

The principle of the Homefinder Scheme is to advertise available properties and give applicants requiring a property the opportunity to express an interest and be considered for a property that is advertised. This is known as bidding.

Adverts will be available to view on line and at various points throughout Bassetlaw.

In preparation for the introduction of the Homefinder Scheme, A1 Housing is sending out review forms to all applicants currently registered on the housing waiting list.

Housing applicants on the waiting list are required to complete the review form and advise A1 Housing of any change in circumstances, so we can make sure that the details that we have on our records are up to date.

This is vitally important as under the Homefinder Scheme, if you successfully bid for a property and your circumstances were different to what we have on our records, this could result in an offer of accommodation being withdrawn.

The review form must be completed and returned by 27th October 2008. If you do not return the review form your housing application will be cancelled and you will not be able to 'bid' for a property under the new scheme.
